I confirm that I am medically fit to participate and that all relevant medical conditions have been disclosed in the Reservation Form. I accept full responsibility for my conduct, safety, and compliance with all applicable laws and the instructions of the Professional Hunter at all times.

I confirm that I have read, understood, and agree to be bound by Annexure A: Terms & Conditions, which forms part of this agreement.

This indemnity shall be governed by the laws of the Republic of South Africa.

ANNEXURE A

TERMS & CONDITIONS

These Terms & Conditions form part of the Safari Agreement between Theron African Safaris ("the Outfitter") and the Client and are binding upon signature of the Reservation Form and Indemnity.

1. BOOKINGS, DEPOSITS & RESCHEDULING

- 1.1. Deposits paid to the booking agent or directly to Theron African Safaris are non-refundable and secure the booking dates and Professional Hunter allocation. Deposits cannot be moved to another hunter without prior written approval from the Outfitter.
- 1.2. Rescheduling fees may apply if you reschedule your hunt. Rescheduling is subject to availability, and any rate increases applicable to the new safari dates.
- 1.3. If you booked as a hunter and opt to be an observer during the hunt, you will be responsible for the observer's daily rate for the entire length of the safari and not just the days spent as an observer, as well as an additional penalty of \$550 to cover the Professional Hunter's pre-booked fees and allocation.

2. SPECIES-SPECIFIC DEPOSITS & PERMITS

- 2.1. To secure the following animals, Theron African Safaris requires the following deposits:
 - 2.1.1. Spotted Hyena: \$500 pre-bait fee and \$500 permit fee – non-refundable once baiting has commenced or permit application submitted.
 - 2.1.2. Buffalo (on quota): 25% refundable deposit applicable only when hunting in the Big 5 Game Reserve and subject to annual quota availability.
 - 2.1.3. Nile Crocodile: \$500 permit fee and 50% deposit on trophy fee.
 - 2.1.4. Lion: \$500 permit fee and 50% deposit on trophy fee.
- 2.2. Baboon, monkeys, and jackal do not form part of the minimum required animals available for harvesting and are subject to availability.
- 2.3. All animals that have "permit" indicated on the price list require a permit in advance. Permits are issued on a first-come, first-served basis until the annual quota is reached and are subject to approval by the relevant authority.
- 2.4. If a client decides to no longer harvest a specific booked animal, written notice must be given at least three (3) months prior to arrival. Failing such notice, 50% of the trophy fee remains payable and is non-negotiable due to quota allocation and opportunity loss.

3. MINIMUM HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1. If a client does not shoot a minimum of three (3) animals during the safari, the client will be charged according to the daily rate of a 2:1 hunt as per the applicable price list for a minimum of seven (7) days, plus the trophy fees for animals harvested.
- 3.2. The initial deposit remains deductible and non-refundable.

4. TROPHY FEES, PRICING & RECOVERY

- 4.1. Trophy fees are payable in full at the end of the hunt prior to departure from camp.
- 4.2. The last and final price list received from Theron African Safaris, not older than three (3) months prior to arrival, is binding and final and supersedes any previous price lists received from the Outfitter, booking agent, or staff members.
- 4.3. Any animal shot, wounded, and lost is considered harvested and subject to the full trophy price. The Professional Hunter's decision as to whether an animal has been wounded shall be final and binding.
- 4.4. The Outfitter will make every reasonable effort to recover wounded animals; however, recovery cannot be guaranteed due to terrain, wildlife movement, or safety considerations.

5. GRATUITIES & PAYMENTS

- 5.1. Payment of gratuities is in US Dollars cash. Should gratuities be added to a credit card, 15% tax on the tipping amount will be added in accordance with South African Government regulations.
- 5.2. Tips are paid to the PH in charge at the end of the hunt and not to individual staff members when moving camp. This ensures fair and equal distribution amongst all staff involved in the safari experience, even those who you don't come into contact with.
- 5.3. All outstanding amounts, including observer fees, extra activities, special dietary charges, and trophy fees, are payable in full at the end of the hunt prior to departure.

6. HUNTING RESTRICTIONS & CONDUCT

- 6.1. Hunting buffalo with a bow is strictly prohibited in the Big 5 Game Reserve.
- 6.2. No hunting will take place if a client is under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances. The Professional Hunter reserves the right to determine whether a client is fit to hunt.

- 6.3. Any use of drugs, illegal substances, or engagement in illicit activities during the safari is strictly prohibited.
- 6.4. Should a client elect to stop the safari or be removed from hunting activities due to the above conduct, a penalty of \$2,500 will apply, payable immediately, and the client may be escorted back to the airport at their own cost.

7. SAFETY, RISK & LIABILITY

- 7.1. Clients acknowledge that hunting and safari activities involve inherent risks, including but not limited to dangerous wild animals, firearms, remote areas, uneven terrain, and extreme weather conditions.
- 7.2. While Theron African Safaris will always do its best to ensure the safety of clients, the Outfitter cannot be held liable for damages, injury, loss of life, or financial loss arising from participation in safari activities, except where prohibited by law.
- 7.3. Clients acknowledge that there are dangerous animals, reptiles, insects, and plants in the game parks and hunting farms and that participation is entirely voluntary.
- 7.4. Clients acknowledge that handling firearms, bows, and crossbows can be dangerous and agree to exercise extreme safety at all times.
- 7.5. Clients acknowledge that their hunt may include physically demanding activities and confirm that they are medically fit to participate.
- 7.6. Clients agree to abide by the decision of the Professional Hunter to dispatch any animal that poses an immediate threat to human life or requires humane termination. The client remains liable for all associated trophy fees and costs.
- 7.7. Any additional costs incurred in life-threatening situations or where other trophies are shot accidentally shall be for the client's account.

8. TAX, EXPORT & INSURANCE

- 8.1. If trophies are not exported, 15% tax will be added to the trophy amount in accordance with South African Government regulations.
- 8.2. Clients are responsible for ensuring compliance with firearm import/export regulations and any necessary permits required by South African authorities.

- 8.3. The Outfitter strongly recommends that every client obtains trip cancellation and emergency medical insurance and is responsible for all medical expenses, evacuation, or emergency services required during the safari.

9. MEDIA & PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 9.1. Photos taken during the safari may be used for promotional and/or publicity purposes by Theron African Safaris unless the client objects in writing prior to the safari.
- 9.2. By signing the reservation form, the client consents to the processing of personal information for purposes related to the safari booking and administration.

10. GENERAL

- 10.1. These Terms & Conditions are essential for the operation of the Hunting Outfitter and the overall safari experience.
- 10.2. The Professional Hunter's decisions regarding safety, hunting conduct, and wounded animals shall be final.
- 10.3. These Terms are governed by the laws of the Republic of South Africa.

11. RELEASE OF CLAIMS

- 11.1. The Client hereby waives, releases, and discharges Theron African Safaris, its directors, officers, Professional Hunters, employees, agents, and representatives from any claims, demands, actions, or causes of action arising from participation in the safari, whether arising from negligence or otherwise, to the fullest extent permitted by the laws of the Republic of South Africa.
- 11.2. This release applies to claims for personal injury, death, property damage, financial loss, emotional distress, or any other loss or damage that may occur during or as a result of participation in the safari.
- 11.3. This release shall be binding upon the Client's estate, heirs, executors, administrators, dependents, and assigns.

12. EMERGENCY MEDICAL TREATMENT & AUTHORITY

- 12.1. In the event of injury, illness, or medical emergency, the Client authorizes Theron African Safaris and/or the Professional Hunter to arrange medical treatment, hospitalization, evacuation, or emergency transportation on the Client's behalf where necessary.
- 12.2. The Client acknowledges that safari areas may be remote and that access to immediate medical facilities may be limited and may require air evacuation.

- 12.3. All medical expenses incurred during the safari, including but not limited to doctor's fees, hospitalization, emergency transport, helicopter evacuation, medication, and repatriation, shall be for the sole account of the Client.
- 12.4. The Outfitter shall not be held liable for decisions made in good faith during emergency situations.

13. FIREARMS & WEAPON RESPONSIBILITY

- 13.1. Clients bringing their own firearms, bows, crossbows, or other hunting equipment confirm that they are legally entitled to possess and use such equipment.
- 13.2. The Client accepts full responsibility for compliance with all applicable South African laws relating to import permits, temporary firearm licenses, ammunition limits, transport, storage, and lawful use.
- 13.3. Theron African Safaris shall not be liable for confiscation, delays, fines, refusal of entry, or legal consequences arising from non-compliance with firearm regulations.
- 13.4. The Client agrees to comply strictly with all safety instructions issued by the Professional Hunter regarding firearm handling at all times.

14. RESPONSIBILITY FOR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY

- 14.1. The Client shall be responsible for any damage caused, whether intentionally or negligently, to vehicles, accommodation, camp facilities, firearms, equipment, or property belonging to Theron African Safaris or third parties.
- 14.2. The cost of repair or replacement of damaged property shall be payable by the Client prior to departure from the safari.
- 14.3. Unsafe handling of firearms or equipment resulting in damage shall be deemed the Client's responsibility.

15. FORCE MAJEURE

- 15.1. Theron African Safaris shall not be held liable for delays, cancellations, interruptions, or changes to the safari caused by events beyond its reasonable control.
- 15.2. Such events include, but are not limited to, natural disasters, extreme weather conditions, disease outbreaks, government restrictions, permit refusals, border closures, political unrest, airline disruptions, or quota limitations.
- 15.3. In such circumstances, safari dates may be rescheduled subject to availability; however, refunds are not automatically guaranteed.

16. TROPHY HANDLING, STORAGE & RELEASE

- 16.1. Trophies shall not be released for dip, pack, taxidermy, export, or shipment until all outstanding amounts have been paid in full.
- 16.2. The Outfitter shall not be responsible for delays in export caused by taxidermists, shipping agents, government authorities, or customs procedures.
- 16.3. Should trophies remain unpaid or uncollected for an unreasonable period, storage fees may apply.

17. PAYMENT METHODS & EXCHANGE RATE

- 17.1. Payments may be made in United States Dollars or South African Rand at the prevailing exchange rate on the date of settlement.
- 17.2. Any bank charges, international transfer fees, credit card surcharges, or related transaction costs shall be for the Client's account.
- 17.3. Interest may be charged on outstanding amounts not settled prior to departure.

18. RIGHT OF REFUSAL

- 18.1. Theron African Safaris reserves the right to refuse participation in hunting activities where, in the opinion of the Professional Hunter, the Client's conduct, physical condition, or safety awareness poses a risk to themselves or others.
- 18.2. Such refusal shall not entitle the Client to a refund of deposits or daily rates.

19. ENTIRE AGREEMENT & SEVERABILITY

- 19.1. These Terms & Conditions, together with the Reservation Form and Indemnity, constitute the entire agreement between the parties.
- 19.2. No amendment or variation shall be binding unless reduced to writing and signed by both parties.
- 19.3. Should any provision of these Terms & Conditions be found invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
